Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: C9: PLS-Francis Coleman, DS, 1851, Set post corner of sections 19,20,29 & 32 - Fir 12", N.21 W., 27 links, Beech 7", S.63 E., 30 links. Alger County Records, George L. Depew, 1916, Set iron corner from original government field notes. No references given. Record of surveys book, page 264. Alger County Records. CCI Forestry Division, Land and Timber Examination Report. T.J. McLaren, 1957, on timber cruise sheet indicates an iron at corner position set by author unknown. No references given.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: C9: Found 2" 6.1.P. w/ 3 1/4" Brass cap stamped to identify corner position, dated march 1916. A search was made at 6LO bearing tree positions. Bearing tree evidence has been lost. Monument position is accepted as a careful and faithful perperpetuation of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

C9: Stamped P.A. 345 in brass cap of cast steel monument. Established the following reference trees w/ BT signs, blazed, scribed and painted. Set PK nails for measure w/ Alum. Maple 11", N.52 E., 28.98 feet, 'S20 BT', Maple 8', 5.74 E., 14.95 feet, " \$29 BT ", Maple 4", N.43 W., 54.75 feet, " \$19 BT ", Beech 4", S.68 W., 45.44 feet, " \$30 BT ", Survey Marker sign on six foot steel fence post, N.28 W., 1.5 feet. All bearings are magnetic.
