- B. Description of comer evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing comer:
- E6: Located corner position by standard field survey and single proportionate measurement. A search was made for original BT's. Area logged heavily in recent past and GLO evidence has been destroyed. Monumented corner position as established. Corner position is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
- E6: Set Berntsen aluminum monument no. AINB30, with 3 1/4" aluminum cap, stamped to identify corner position. Established the following reference trees with BT signs, blazed, scribed and painted. Set PK nails for measure with aluminum I.D. washers in the following trees. \* Maple 5", N.54°W., 12.39 feet, "1/4S BT"; \* Maple 14", N.86°E., 35.43 feet, "1/4S BT"; \* Beech 4", S.49°W., 14.68 feet, "1/4S BT"; \* Beech 16", S.53°E., 27.97 feet, "1/4S BT"; \* Survey marker sign on 6 foot steel post, S.35°E., 1.0 feet. All bearings are magnetic.
