- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
- (A-6) Corner not set in original survey. Monumented 1885 by Allegan County Surveyor, J.W. Hicks who set "long stone near 3' in length point up and a X on top at corner".
- (A-7) Corner perpetuated CA. 1885 by Allegan County Surveyor who set "stone about 20" long broken alittle on S. edge". County surveyor records do not mention GLO monument or accessories. Corner recorded by D. A. Ratekin, 1973 as set 1/2" iron with cap on old fence line east and fence line to south.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner;
- (A-6) Found newer wire fence going east from corner location with remains of much older wire fence at its base. Traced fence to 6001 east of corner location and conclude that newer fence represents location of older. Projected fence line westerly to intersection with range line. This position falls 1.5' N of a point equidistant between A-5 and A-7. Excavated 3'x3'x1.5' deep hole at this position and found nothing. Accepted fence line as perpetuation of old county surveyor monument and set 1/2"x36" long re-rod encased in 4" dia. concrete cylinder with cast aluminum Mich. Dept. of Natural Resources cap on the range line at its intersection with the westerly projection of fence line.
- (A-7) Particle found and accepted 1/2" re-rod with cap # 8781 5" below gravel surface. Ratekin's road calls check. Other accessories not found. Distance A-7 to B-7 checks well with distant shown on survey Rec. L. 828 - p.406.
