- (M-8) John Mullet, Deputy Surveyor, set wood post for original monument, 1826. Accessories: W.Oak 14" N26 1/2 W, 39.60', W. Oak 12" S80 1/2 W, 5.94'. Corner shown on map by W.G. Fargo, Engineer, Ca. 1900 of flowage of the then proposed Plainwell Dam and of parcels eventually acquired by the power company operating the dam. No monument type or accessories specified. Corner also referred to in description on deed Rec. L.126 - P. 234, Allegan County records, dated 1902 which also notes accessories to the P.O.B. 515 feet South of corner.
- (K-9) Corner recorded by Donald A. Ratekin, RLS 8781, June, 1971 as found stone with "x" on top. Accessories noted on L.C.R.C. L.1 - P4.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- (M-8) No monumentation or accessories recovered. Accessories noted in deed not found. Found N-S wire fence along range line which runs from Miller Road South to the Kalamazoo River but no acceptable evidence of latitudinal position of corner recovered. Accepted fence as evidence of old corner location and set monument in fence equidistant from M-7 (Rec. L.2 - P.249) and M-9 (Rec. L.3 - P.188). From this position, distance South to top of Northerly bank of Kalamazoo River matches well with distance call of 880' from deed above. Monument is 0.6' west of straight line between M-7 and M-9.
- (K-9) Found and accepted stone with "x" on top 1.4' below ground surface and placed 1" pipe with cap # 26453 above "x". Three remaining accessories by Ratekin check as noted below.
