A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1855: G.L.O. Re-survey by Josiah Knauer - set post and referenced: Hemlock  $18 - S69 \frac{1}{2W} - 12 / Sugar 8 - N61 \frac{1}{2E} - 19$ .

1977: Survey by Duane MacNeill - referenced.

1978: Survey by Duane MacNeill - set 1/2" rerod with cap and referenced.

1979: Survey by Duane MacNeill - referenced.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

1993: Set 1/2" rebar from 1979 Duane MacNeill witnesses obtained from a survey recorded in liber 1 pg 973. Corner falls 1' South of the Center of a winding trail road. MacNeill set this corner in 1978 from a combination of prorations and found evidence in Sec. 9 from the 1918 plat of Lakeside Rod & Gun Club. This corner is compatible with 1855 G.L.O. survey and is a reference for local surveys. This corner appears to be the best evidence of the true position.

Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

1993: Set 1/2" x 18" iron rod with 3" aluminum cap stamped to identify the corner. Referenced:
