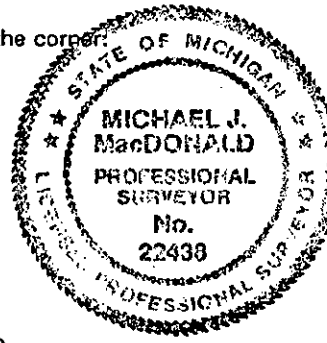

SEARCHED THE APPARENT LOCATION OF THE CORNER AND FOUND 6" BELOW THE SURFACE OF THE ROAD A LARGE ROCK ABOVE 5/8" BAR PER WITNESSES, L. 2, P. 155. DUG FURTHER AND FOUND A BURIED CABLE 36" BELOW SURFACE. ACCEPTED THE 5/8" BAR AS THE BEST AVAILABLE EVIDENCE OF THE POSITION OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER.
