- (12) Center of Section 1. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.

(7-Sec. 1) North 1/16 corner between Section 1 T47M-R34W and Section 6 T47M-R33W. Corner not established in the original survey. found no subsequent record.

(9-Sec. 1) East 1/16 corner Section 1. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.

- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner;
- (12) Established the corner at the intersection of straight lines connecting opposite 1/4 corners, all monumented. Found a 1° iron pipe projecting about 4 ft. and capped with a Misconsin-Michigan Power Co. cap, MSBM 62.74' from the corner. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1°1.0.x32° iron pipe capped with a 4° dia, cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped.

(7-Sec. 1) Found no evidence of prior monumentation at the corner position. Established the corner on a straight line between 1/4 corner 1308.87' south and township corner 1305.59' north, being 20 chains, proportionate to the original record, morth of the 1/4 corner. At the position for the corner I placed a 1°IDx32" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDMR tablet, appropriately stamped. M-S cut traverse line is 8' west.

(9-Sec. 1) Found no evidence of prior monumentation. Established the corner midway and on a straight line between quarter corner 1320.15' east and Center of section 1320.15' west. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1'I.D.x32' iron pipe capped with a 4" dis. cast aluminum MDWR tablet, appropriately stamped.
