A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(I5) Corner common to Sections 10-11-14-15. 1848 - Established by Wells Burt Deputy Surveyor. Set spruce post. Spruce 8 N61W 27 links, Spruce 7 S40E 46 links. 1957 - Dean C. DeLaMater RLS searched for the original corner in 1957 on behalf of the Michigan Dept. of Conservation. He found a squared post by others but no original evidence.

(4-Sec. 14) Northwest 1/16 corner, Section 14. Not established in the original survey.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(I5) The original post and accessories were not recovered. Found 3 rotted post points, and a newer wooden post, all adjacent - all apparently the perpetuation of an approximate corner position. From the position of the post, the record position by double proportionate measurement between corners 1 mi. west, north, east, and 1/2 mi. south is S62E 56.5'. I conclude that the post's position is not a perpetuation of the original corner position, is not supported by the original record, and I do not accept it as perpetuating the position of the original corner. I reestablished the corner at the proportionate position, noted above, between corners 5279.43' West, 5207.44' North, 5279.35' East, and 2604.02' South. I note that it is common in this township to find the N-S distances between corners to be substantially short of the GLO record.

(4-Sec. 14) Established the corner at the intersection of straight lines connecting opposite 1/16 corners.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(I5) Set 1"IDx32" I.pipe with 4" alum. MDNR cap. Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of: mrkd "S11 NBT" 6" Tamarack N67E 6.65' "S14 NBT" 7" B.Spruce S14E 24.05' "S15 NBT" 4" Tamarack S66W 4.65' "S10 NBT" 7" Tamarack N30W 20.8' Set sq'd Tam. post adjacent. Bearings are magnetic.

(4) Set 1"IDx32" I.pipe with 4" alum. MDNR cap. Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:

6" B.Spruce N42E 17.3' mrkđ "1/16S BT" 5" Hemlock S86E 31.9' do

3" Sugar S11E 14.75' do 4" Balsam S60W 22.05'
