I, Arthur O. Enger do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above (identified with circles on index code diagram—over) were, in a field survey on December 7 1973, established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered or restored as expressed below and in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a court of law. Furthermore, that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were, in a field survey on \_\_\_\_\_ 19\_\_\_\_, found, recovered, restored, established or re-established as expressed below and in conformance with the rules of the Michigan State Board of Registration for Land Surveyors or, by a Decree of a Court of law:

**A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:**

- Corner A4: Found no evidence of original post or its accessories or of any replacement monuments or accessories.
- Corner A5: Found no evidence of original post or its accessories. Found a 3"x3"x6' scribed cedar post in place, no accessories visible.

**B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:**

- Corner A4: Re-established on line between Sec. Cor. 40.704 ch. to N and to S.
- Corner A5: Re-monumented corner at the scribed post, which was set by unknown parties, but had obviously been there for many years. Position agrees with stream crossings to N and to E, and is consistent with an original 1/4 cor. 40.338 ch. S.

**C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:**

- Corner A4: 1" I.D. x 36" iron pipe with 3½" aluminum cap.  
Tamarack 12 S75°E (mag.) 15.0 ft. "1/4S, NBT"  
Tamarack 13 N24°E (mag.) 15.1 ft. "1/4S, NBT"
- Corner A5: 1" I.D. x 36" iron pipe with 4" aluminum cap.  
W. Pine 21 S81½°W (mag.) 100.8 ft. "S12, NBT"  
W. Pine 18 S54°E (mag.) 140.1 ft. "S18, NBT"
