Szyszkoski..., in a field survey on A9 November 02, 1993. do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(AB) Section corner common to sections 19-30 T48N-R32W, and sections 24-25 T48N-R33W. Corner established in 1846 by Austin Burt. Original record shows 1) Cedar 10 S27E 15, 2) Cedar 10 M25W 7, 3) Spruce 12 S54E 27, 4) Cedar 14 M40E 52, 5) Spruce 8 S04W 8, 6) South 8.5 ch. leave swamp C. SE, 7) North 5.00 ch. Leave swamp, 8) East 3.00 ch. Leave swamp course MAS and enter high land. (C13) Section corner common to Sections 31-32 T48M-R32W, and Sections 5-8, T47M-R32W. Corner perpetuated and recorded by Neal Sperhake ALS, in 1980, by a 1° iron pipe with an aluminum Kimberly-Clark Corp. cap placed from original bearing tree Sugar 12 S59E 15. Sperhake also found a Northern Paper Mills pipe with brass cap. NPM (now Ned Lake) records show that Sugar OBT SSSE was found in 1939 with iron marks plain, and no trace of other OBTs. In 1954 NPM forester D.L. Buell set a pipe at record bearing and distance from the Sugar OBT and marked two new BTs: Sugar & S&IW 41, Sugar 10 M42E 50.5 links. Sperhake's 1960 MBTs: Maple 8 M30W 56 links, Maple 7 S&OE 54 links.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(A9) Original post not recovered. Accessories 1) through 5) referenced above were not recovered. Found corner location marked by 2 old squared posts, and a newer white C.F.I. post, the oldest post probably being in excess of 50 yrs. old. Two old cedar signature trees face the corner, the earliest observed date being 1933. A 1958 Celotex location poster and a second L.P. dated 1953 also face the corner. The posts check with the record as referenced in 6) through 8) above very well. Distance east to a probable original corner location at the section corner common to 20-21-28-29 checks with the record. Accepted the location of the posts as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner and monumented this position with a 1° I.D.x32° iron pipe capped with a 4° dia. cast aluminum MDNA tablet.

(C13) Found and accepted a 1° pipe with 4° aluminum XC cap and a MPM pipe with 2° brass cap adjacent at record bearing and distance from the MBTs noted above. Maple M30M is still green and now 14° with blaze overgrown, Maple M42E is dead and down, Maple S60E observed to be \$56E 35.2', a 13' tree with overgrown blazes, Maple \$81W observed to be \$84W 27.4' a dead stub with scribing visible. Marked 3 new bearing trees as described below.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(A9) Set 1" pipe with 4" aluminum cap. Blazed and scribed the following new bearing trees: 7° Cedar \$35£ 3.6'

(C13) Found 1° pipe with Kimberly Clark Corp. aluminum cap stamped "Sperhake #7876 10-7-60.

Blazed and scribed the following new "S30 NBT" 7° Cedar N45E 9.6' 'S19 NBT' bearing trees: 11" Cedar \$348 24.1" "\$25 NBT" 10" Sugar N21E 11.2" 'S32 KBT' 13' Sugar N30W 7.5' 1531 HBT" 12° Cedar N81W 32.8' 'S24 NBT'

14" Cedar with location poster and old sig, tree, found squared \$55W 7.7'

10" Twin Sugar \$19E 10.2" "\$5 MBT" with Celotex poster affixed.

12° Cedar old sig. tree dated to 1933 M38E 13.9'
