A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Corners M2, M3, L3: Original monument or accessories not found.
 Corner 16: Not set on original survey or subsequently apparently.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:

Corner M2: Re-established 11-4-75 on line between section corners north and south. Old signature tree 16" Cedar S05°E (Mag.) 92.8 ft.
 Corner M3: Re-established 5-19-75 at the spot where old post stood. This post witnessed by Highway Department in 1944.
 Corner L3: Re-established 4-25-75 on line between section corners.

Corner 16: Established 4-24-75 on line between section corner east and $\frac{1}{4}$ corner west.

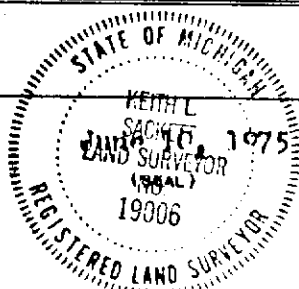
