A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

A-1, M-1; Section Corner common to Section 6, T50N, R32W and Section 1, T50N, R33W.

Originally established during U.S. Survey conducted by William Burt, D.S. in 1846 and monumented with a hemlock post witnessed by a

Yellow Pine 16 S56°W 4 lks. (Recovered as a stump hole.)

and a

Yellow Pine 16 S59°E 13 lks. (Recovered as a stump hole.)

This corner was recovered by Michael Avery and Stephen Douglas of the Bureau of Land Management during the course of a survey conducted from 17 September 1982 to 30 September 1983 and approved 8 July 1985. According to field notes of this survey both U.S. bearing trees were recovered as badly decayed pine stumps of indeterminate size having no marks visible. The BLM did not remonument the original closing corner but rather established an amended position at the intersection of the range line with the correction line and monumented it with a 2½" aluminum pipe with a 3" cap appropriately stamped as to location. Per the BLM field notes the original closing corner bears S00°01'W a distance of 0.149 chains (9.83 feet) from the amended monument. The BLM established the following new bearing trees for the amended monument:

Maple 6 S14°E 165 lks.

Maple 6 S35°W 170 lks.

- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner.
  - A-1, M-1; Section Corner common to Section 6, T50N, R32W and Section 1, T50N, R33W.

Set 1" (I.D.)  $\times$  36" galvanized iron pipe with 2" aluminum cap appropriately stamped as to location at the position of the original closing corner. This corner is located in an old clear cut having grown back as an aspen stand.
