- A. Description of orginal monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
 - G-13; Section Corner common to Section 33 and 34, T51N, R30W, on 5th Correction Line.

Originally established during U.S. Survey conducted by Austin Burt, D.S. in 1845 and monumented by a 3" maple witnessed by a

Sugar 14 N67°E 24 lks. (Gone)

and a

Sugar 10 N28°W 46 lks. (Gone)

The late Norman Thompson, RLS #4348 states in his field notes dated 11 September 1946 (copies of which were obtained from the Northern Hardwoods' office in L'Anse) that he "set cor 33 & 34, no B.T., old marks and sq. sug. 10", ok from creek west branch Huron River, set cedar post". Mr. Thompson noted the following new bearing trees:

Hemlock 4 N11°E 14.1'

(Presently alive and 10" in dia. having a healed mid-trunk blaze.

Set 60d spike W/side N09°E 14.10')

and a

Yellow Birch 7 N67°W 21.3' (Recovered as a severely decayed stump 6" tall having no visible marks. Measured N70°W 21.6')

- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner.
 - G-13; Section Corner common to Section 33 and 34, T51N, R30W, on 5th Correction Line.

Replaced found cedar post with a 1" (I.D.) x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 2" aluminum cap appropriately stamped as to location.
