
C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Found a copper rod with a 1½" brass cap stamped "LLS 21583" 6 inches below the road surface and in a monument box.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

C-11; Section Corner common to Sections 29, 30, 31, and 32, T51N, R33W;

Originally established during U.S. Survey conducted by Harvey Mellen, D.S. in 1845 and monumented with a sugar maple post witnessed by a

Hemlock 12 S47°E 23 lks. and a Hemlock 20 N39°W 22 lks.

This corner was reestablished in 1981 by Brian Taavola, PS #21583 "from Michigan Department of Transportation Plans dated 1956 file #N-23-A-3 and by prorating distances between section corners to west and east". Refer to LCRC prepared by Mr. Taavola and recorded in Liber 4 on page 18 of the Baraga County Land Corner Records. Mr. Taavola monumented the corner with a ½" copper rod with a 1½" brass cap set inside of a monument box. He noted the following accessories:

Power Pole N45°W 79.23' 8" Poplar N05°E 82.14' Top of R.O.W. S05°E 103.23' Marker NW Cor. Garage S13°W 108.00'

Mr. Taavola's corner was accepted by the BLM during the course of their 1984 survey of T51N, R33W.
