This corner was considered lost and reestablished midway and on line between the section corners immediately to the north and to the south by the Bureau of Land Management during the course of a survey conducted by Stephen Douglas from 10 May 1984 to 10 November 1984 and approved 23 September 1985. According to the BLM field notes, this position falls in the center of a north-south graded gravel road. The BLM set a 9/16" x 30" copperweld and noted the following accessories:

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found a  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 28" iron rod set vertically over the BLM copperweld. Replaced the found iron rod with a 1"(I.D.) x 36" galvanized iron pipe with a 2" aluminum cap. Accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
