A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

F-3; One-quarter Corner common to Sections 4 and 9, T51N, R33W;

Originally established during U.S. Survey conducted by Harvey Mellen, D.S. in 1845 and monumented with a sugar maple post witnessed by a

During the course of a survey conducted by Stephen Douglas of the Bureau of Land Management from 10 May 1984 to 10 November 1984 and approved 23 September 1985, this corner was found to be "monumented with a mound of stone, 12 ins. diam., 5 ins. high alongside a fence cor. with fences extending N., E. and S.; from which the remains of the orig. bearing trees: A stump hole, bears N.54°E., 24 lks. dist. (and) A stump hole, bears S.18°W., 10 lks. dist.". The BLM set a 2½° x 30" aluminum pipe with a cap in a "collar of stone" and noted the following new hearing trees: noted the following new bearing trees:

Presently alive and 16" in diameter having a partially open lower blaze with scribing visible.
