On 20 July 1977, Keith Sackett, P.S. #19006 recovered and accepted a \*1 (in.) steel axle shaft. According to a Land Corner Recordation Certificate prepared by Mr. Sackett dated 3 August 1977 and recorded on 20 December 1977 in Volume 1 on page 489 of the Houghton County Land Corner Records, this monument was left in place and the following accessories were established:
