B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

D-9; One-quarter Corner common to Sections 20 and 29, T52N, R33W;

Found a 1" diameter iron pipe with a broken 4" diameter aluminum cap projecting 22" above ground as set by Mr. Bray. This monument was found set at the base of an old cedar post six feet in length and approximately 4" in diameter squared at the top with the number "20" scribed on two sides and the number "½" scribed on one side. Mr. Bray noted the following accessories:

12" Cedar S82°E 9 lks. (5.94')
Presently alive and 17" in diameter having a 3.5 foot long, mostly open, lower blaze with illegible scribing.
