On page 4 of the Baraga Township Highways Journal, the centerline of the Keweenaw Bay and Otter Lake Road (presently known as Sturgeon Road) was described as passing through this corner (entry dated 30 August 1900). On page 52 of the Highways Journal, Louis Nicholson, County Surveyor, described a road (presently known as Cemetery Road) as beginning at the ¼ corner between sections 29 and 32 and running northwesterly. In 1973, Dennis Destrampe, PS #18993 recorded a boundary survey of a 5 acre parcel in the SW corner of the SE¼ of NW¼ of section 32. Mr. Destrampe's survey indicates the ¼ corner between sections 29 and 32 as a found 1½" diameter iron bar with the following accessories: bar with the following accessories:
