During the course of a survey conducted by Stephen Douglas of the Bureau of Land Management from 10 May 1984 to 10 November 1984 and approved 23 September 1985, a 2" diameter iron pipe as set by Marshall J. Hall, Junior Engineer, U.S. Indian Service, in 1935 was recovered. The BLM field notes state that

"The field notes of the 1935 Marshall J. Hall survey, indicate that this position is the cor. common to secs. 3, 4, 33, and 34. However, the orig. record indicates two distinct cor. positions, the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, and the closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4, which are 23 lks. apart. A retracement of the line bet. secs. 33 and 34, T. 52N, R. 33W., and a retracement of the 1882 survey of the Duluth, Southshore and Atlantic R.R. confirmed the position to be the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, and not the closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4.".
