A. Description of original m	nonument and accessories and/or	subsequent restoration:		

- (E8) Quarter corner common to Sections 20 and 21. 1849 Established by Wm.A.Burt Deputy Surveyor midway and on line between Section corners 40.00 chains north and south. Set Tamarack post. Tamarack 6" N44E 13 links, Tamarack 4 S61W 36 links. 1907 - Recovered by Wm.W.Stockly, engineer during his subdivision of Section 21. No new witnesses of record.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- (E8) Recovered the point of the original Tamarack corner post, rotted off at the level of the water table, sound below, at record bearing and distance from the stump remains of the BT Tamarack S61W 36 links, with open faces and scribing visible. The BT NE was not recovered. Found a second post point adjacent to the original post point, smaller, which had been driven in at an angle, and which probably served as a backsight during the 1907 Stockly survey. Replaced the point of the original Tamarack post with a monument as described below. Assistance in monumentation was provided by Patrick Leemon RLS and members of the Michigan Technological University's Douglas Houghton Student Chapter of the Michigan Society of Professional Surveyors. The remains of the Tamarack BT and the original post are in the possession of said Chapter.
