FOUND STONE AND 1" IRON AS DESCRIBED BY RATEKIN FOUND CHISELED "X" AS DESCRIBED BY KING CHECKED DISTANCES TO C-5 AND D-5, GOOD MATCH WITH KING'S SURVEY. CHECKED DISTANCES TO E-4, E-6 AND E-7, GOOD MATCH WITH SURVEY BY PIKE. CHECKED 16TH LINE OCCUPATION NORTH, SOUTH AND WEST, RESULTS INCONCLUSIVE. ACCEPTED POSITION OF STONE AS BEST EVIDENCE AVAILABLE FOR CORNER POSITION.
