

SEARCHED AT APPARENT LOCATION OF CORNER AND FOUND 11 "STEEL PIPE FENCE POST IN A 2" GALVANIZED PIPE BASE IN AN EAST-WEST FENCE AT ANCIENT FENCE TO SOUTH AND 18.6 FEET EAST OF FENCE TO NORTH. ALTHOUGH THERE IS NO RECORD OF COUNTY SURVEYOR ESTABLISHMENT OF CORNER A.C. WILSON, COUNTY SURVEYOR CALLS FOR CENTER OF SECTION IN A SURVEY RECORDED IN LIBER 2, PAGE 189 IN NOV. 1867 AS ESTABLISHED FROM PREVIOUS SURVEY. THIS SURVEYOR IS OF THE OPINION THAT WILLSON ESTABLISHED F-1 AT THE TIME OF "PREVIOUS SURVEY" DURING ONE OF THE PERIODS WHEN HE WAS NOT IN OFFICE AS THE COUNTY SURVEYOR. A TRAVERSE OF SECTION 4, T2N, R7W SHOW FENCE CORNER TO BE ALMOST A SPLIT OF ENTIRE MEASURED DISTANCE ALONG THE SECTION LINE. ACCEPTED FENCE CORNER AS CORNER AS ESTABLISHED BY A.C. WILLSON AND SET STANDARD BARRY COUNTY MONUMENT ON THE NORTH SIDE OF 2" PIPE.
