2. SETH PRATT, COUNTY SURVEYOR SET STONE IN ROAD IN APRIL 1890 FROM LIVING GOVERNMENT WITNESS TREE (MAPLE GROVE FIELD BOOK PAGES 3 & 9)

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

SEARCHED AT APPARENT LOCATION OF CORNER AND FOUND 3" BAR & CAP #18988 IN SOUTH EDGE OF BIVENS ROAD ON TREE LINE TO NORTH N45°W, 6.2' FROM 52" OAK STUMP. AGREE WITH SURVEYOR FLUKE THAT STUMP IS THE REMAINS OF THE ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT WITNESS BUT DO NOT AGREE WITH HIS METHOD OF SETTING THE CORNER. IT IS THIS SURVEYORS OPINION THAT CORNER SHOULD BE 9.2' FROM THE CENTER OF SAID STUMP. ACCORDINGLY SET STANDARD BARRY COUNTY MONUMENT 9.2' FROM CENTER OF STUMP AND ON FENCE LINE TO NORTH. IT IS THIS SURVEYORS OPINION THAT THIS LOCATION IS THE SAME AS THE ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT CORNER. **ACT 345 BARRY COUNTY REMONUMENTATION**
