ON MAY 31, 1995 EXCAVATED 4' X 4' HOLE TO A DEPTH OF 4' AND FOUND THAT BAR WAS AN AXLE SHAFT WITH MUCH BROKEN BRICK AND CROCKERY AROUND IT. DID NOT FIND ANY TRACE OF THE STONE. ACCEPTED AXLE AS CORNER AS PERPETUATED BY AN UNKNOWN SURVEYOR. RETURNED ON SEPTEMBER 25, 1996 TO SET MONUMENT AND FOUND THAT ROAD COMMISSION HAD SET A 6" PVC PIPE AROUND THE AXLE, POURED CONCRETE AROUND PVC AND SET A MONUMENT BOX ABOVE IT.
