FOUND 1/2" CAPPED REROD ON CENTERLINE OF AN EAST-WEST GRAVEL ROAD AS PER C.M.P. WITNESSES BY JONKER. TRAVERSED SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 2, TYING IN FOUND CORNERS AND OCCUPATION LINES. THE CORNER LOCATION ESTABLISHED BY JONKER FITS A PROPORTIONAL MEASURE OF THE DISTANCES REPORTED BY RORK FOR HIS SURVEY OF SECTION 2. THIS CORNER POSITION LIES IN A GRAVEL ROADBED BUILT OVER A SWAMP. IT APPEARS QUITE UNLIKELY THAT AN EXCAVATION AT THIS CORNER WOULD REVEAL THE "POST" RECITED BY BOWEN; HOWEVER, SUCH AN EXCAVATION COULD DESTABILIZE THE ROADBED. ACCEPTED THE IRON BY JONKER AS A PROPER RESTORATION OF THE CORNER LOCATION. REPLACED FOUND IRON WITH STANDARD BARRY COUNTY REMONUMENTATION IRON AND CAP. ACT 345 BARRY COUNTY REMONUMENTATION
