
A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Michigan Department of Conservation 1947 Shadko found bottom of fence corner 12" Oak West 27.6' post at intersection of fences, set Monument 8" above ground, not witnessed. 1947 distance to E-5 2639.8

Van Kooten 1958 found Department of Conservation brass cap monument 8" Oak SE 30.3

10" Oak SSW 35.4 fence South and East 2640.6 to E-5 1958

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found Department of Conservation brass cap monument as recorded in LCRC# 467. Property owner to the Southwest testified that when he bought the land, C. 1972, the monument was lying flat on the surface. Inspected brass cap, found it to be top half only of 4' long monument. Checked Van Kooten witnesses, dug and found bottom half intact 8'± West of previously recorded position. Accepted as corner
