B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

FOUND 3/4" PIPE IN THE ROOTS OF A LARGE ASH TREE. FOUND ALL WITNESSES BY MULDER (ITEM #3 & #4 ABOVE). CORNER LIES IN A LARGE HEAVILY WOODED (MOSTLY ASH BEECH & ELM) SEASONAL SWAMP. FOUND PIPE CONFORMS VERY WELL WITH CORRESPONDING CORNERS AND OCCUPATION THROUGHOUT SECTION.

ACCEPTED FOUND 3/4" PIPE AS BEST AVAILABLE EVIDENCE OF CORNER POSITION.

WERE NOT ABLE TO REMOVE PIPE AS IT IS IN THE ROOTS OF A LARGE ASH.

PLACED STANDARD BARRY COUNTY REMONUMENTATION ALUMINUM CAP OVER FOUND PIPE.

FOUND NAIL WITH CAP IN THE SOUTH SIDE OF A 12" MAPLE N75°W 47.84'
FOUND NAIL WITH CAP IN THE EAST SIDE OF A 14" MAPLE S4°W 29.11'
SET 20d NAIL W/REMON TAG IN THE SOUTHEAST SIDE OF AN 18" BEECH S27°W 44.63'
