- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
 IT APPEARS THAT THE DISTANCE DATA RECITED IN THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE NOTES ARE GROSSLY IN ERROR, AS TO BOTH THE CLOSING DISTANCE AND THE FALLING BETWEEN STANDARD AND CLOSING CORNERS (CLOSING 1/2 MILE 2502.06' GLO, 2391.49' MEASURED; FALLING 21.12' GLO, 82.46' MEASURED) FOUND IRON FOR M-9, T4N R9W. CONDUCTED EXTENSIVE SEARCH FOR CORNER EVIDENCE FOR A-9 AND FOUND NOTHING. INTERSECTED THE PROJECTED LINE FROM C-9 THROUGH B-9 WITH THE RANGE LINE DEFINED BY M-9 AND M-8. T4N R9W. THIS POSITION IS CONSISTENT WITH OCCUPATION LINES FOR 1/4 LINE AND 1/8 LINE. THIS IS THE METHOD THAT SHOULD HAVE BEEN, BUT APPARENTLY WAS NOT, FOLLOWED BY THE GLO DEPUTY SURVEYOR. THE EXISTENCE OF OCCUPATION LINES CONSISTENT WITH THIS POSITION INDICATE THAT SURVEYS (NOT OF RECORD) MANY YEARS AGO USED THE SAME METHOD.

ACCEPTED THIS METHOD OF RESTORATION AS THE BEST POSSIBLE WAY TO RESTORE THE CORNER PROBABLY NEVER SET BY THE GLO DEPUTY SURVEYOR
