B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

FOUND 3/4" PIPE FROM BONNEMA'S WITNESSES (OAK ESE, ASH WEST, & FENCE NORTH) SEARCHED FOR OTHER EVIDENCE OF MONUMENTATION, FOUND NOTHING. CRESSY'S DISTANCE TO J-5 IS SIGNIFICANTLY LONGER THAN BONNEMA'S; CRESSY'S NOTES INDICATE THAT HE FOUND NO LOCAL EVIDENCE OF CORNER, THAT HE REESTABLISHED BY RUNNING LINE FROM I-6 NORTH TO MEANDER POST AT THORNAPPLE RIVER AND SET CORNER ON LINE, PRESUMABLY AT PROPORTIONAL DISTANCE. IT SEEMS CERTAIN THAT THE CORNER SET BY BONNEMA IS A NUMBER OF FEET EAST OF THE POSITION BY CRESSY; HOWEVER, GIVEN THE RESULTING SECTION MEASUREMENTS, IT APPEARS BONNEMA'S POSITION MORE ACCURATELY APPROXIMATES THE POSITION SET BY THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE SURVEY.
