A-2 Set post - J. Wampler, 1822 Ash 32" S 31° W 18 Lks. Ash 16" N 26° W 14 Lks.



A-3 Set post - J. Wampier, 1822. Ash 18" S 2° 48 Lks. Eim 38" N 32° W 29 Lks.

Unrecorded survey by Edmands Engineering MS - 642 - 1970. Sec. 7, T17N, R5E. Set 3/8" rebar. Recorded surveys L. 929, P. 65 - 1982, and L. 929, P. 68 - 1982. Found 3/8" rebar.

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B. Description of corner evidence fourid attack in method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

A-2 Standard 1/4 corner common to Sec. 6, T17N, R5E, and Sec. 1, T17N, R4E. Found PS #27595 cap on 1/2" x 1/8" rebar. Apparently set by single proportional measure between A1 and A3, T17N, R5E. Monument accepted as a careful and faithful re-establishment of the position of the original corner. Accepted by Bay County Peer Review Group on 12-9-93.

A-3 Standard Section corner common to Sec. 6 and 7, T17N, R5E, and Sec. 1 and 12, T17N, R4E. Found PS #27595 cap on 1/2" x 18" rebar at apparent location of record 3/8" rebar. Fits recorded witness tie to U.P. per L. 929, P. 65. In agreement with distance and angle ties per Ledy Engineering and Wade-Trim, Inc., to S. Record distance E to 1/8 corner per recorded surveys witness ties in disagreement by 1'±. Monument accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. Accepted by Bay County Peer Review Group on 12-9-93.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

A-2 Replace capped rebar with 2-3/4" Bay County brass cap on 5/8" x 24" rebar in mon. box.

N 63° W 77.58' to PK and tag in NE wingwall of RR bridge - above '1951'.

S  $42^{\circ}$  W 162.52' to N top bolt at base of NW leg of power line tower.

S 15° E 48.86' to nail and tag in E side U.P.

S 56° E 93.26' to nail and tag in N side 10" Ash.

 $\underline{\text{A-3}}$  Replace capped rebar with 2-3/4" Bay County brass cap on 5/8" x 24" rebar in mon. box.

N 8° E 32.34' to nail and tag in W side wood post.

S 5° W 38.82' (38.70' (R) to centerline) to nall and tag in E side

S 70° W 30.31' to capped 3/8" rebar.

S 60° E 33.61' to capped 3/8" rebar.
