1838: GLO set post and witnesses – 10" Beech N66°W 50 links and 7" Beech N70°E 23 links. 1911: Frank Haswell, Survey Record II, Page 116, shows break of East ½ of section 31 with numbers. Also shows he found old stake and drove 1" x 4' long iron pipe. 1964: BCRC records show they found a 1 ½" iron pipe and their sketch shows that it is 6.7' North of centerline of road. Their records also showed that they had set a POT, a ¾" iron south of the corner. This work was done prior to rebuilding the road in 1964 or 1965. 1969: Bill Batzer found the BCRC POT and used it for the section corner and witnessed it. 1974: Harold Bruning used BCRC POT. 1988 Max Harris did a section break of Section 31 and used the BCRC POT for the corner. 1996: Bruce Jenema, in a Certificate of Survey filed in Liber 76, page 2, shows he used BCRC POT.
