Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: B-11: 1838: GLO set post - Sugar 14" S45°E 6 links and Hemlock 10" N58°W 16 links. 1867: George Steele, Highway route survey shows he started from this corner. 1867: George Steele notes show he reset the corner from the original bearing trees. 1905 (approx.): Guy Langford, Surveyors Record No. 2, Page 52, shows he did work in section but did not mention this corner. 1995: Bruce Jenema in a unrecorded Certificate of Survey shows he reset the corner at a single proportionate position between the adjacent section corners.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: B-11: 1997: Found a 1/2" x 18" rebar with no cap which fits Jenema witnesses. The Benzie County Peer Group accepted the Jenema iron as the single proportionate replacement of the GLO corner.
