F-9 1838; GLO set post - Sugar 14 S46°E 25 links and Sugar 8" N25°W 25 links. 1871; George Steele, Surveyor's Record No. 1, page 78, shows distance to Center of section. 1987: BCRC found 1" iron in gravel road and witnessed it. 1993: Max Harris in an unrecorded Certificate of Survey, found an iron bar in a gravel road and witnessed it.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

F-9: 1998: Found a 1" x 25" drift pin, 27" below the grade of the new existing asphalt road. Iron was found from old Max Harris and BCRC witnesses. The Benzie County Peer Group accepted the iron bar as being the best evidence of a locally accepted corner.
