Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: J-11: 1838: GLO set post - Sugar 12" N35°W 7 links and W. Ash 14" S10°W 44 links. GLO distances to East and West are both 2641.98'. 1866: George Steele, Survey Reccord I, Page 82, shows he measured distance from J-11 to K-11 of 2640'. 1961: MDOT found old boatspike and witnessed it. MDOT shows distance to section corner to West of 2699.01'. 1964: Harold R. Bruning fond boatspike and sets iron pipe on East R/W of M-22 on section line to the West. Bruning distance to the West is 2696.54'. 1968: Bruning refound boatspike and worked on line to center of section to north. 1995: John Smendzuik, finds boatspike in old road bed and per MDOT witnesses. Also found Bruning iron pipe to West as shown by Bruning. B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: J-11: 1998: Found boatspike and 2 MDOT witnesses in centerline of old gravel road bed. Boatspike fits all occupation lines per 1938 aerial photos at BCRC. Rough scale on 1938 photos show the West 1/2 of south line of Section 26 is longer than the East 1/2. Actual; distances are 2696.54' on the West 1/2 and 2578.99'. This total fits within 8' of GLO distance along this line. Occupations on East 1/2 of this line fit well with old 1915 Atlas of Benzie County. Even though the boatspike may not be at the GLO location, per GLO distances, the Benzie County Peer Group accepted the boatspike as the best evidence of a locally accepted corner, at least since 1915 and also per the 1938 photos. C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: J-11: Replaced the boatspike with a 3" diameter Benzie County Remonumentation Program concrete monument with a brass cap, 2" above existing grade. 8" Maple N05°W 24.01' to set nail and BCRP tag. Ratified by Peer Group 10" W. Birch S52°E 27.30' to set nail and BCRP tag. In accordance with P. 11" Basswood S14°W 30.29' to set nail and BCRP tag (MDOT witness). 13" W. Birch S58°W 30.53' to set nail and BCRP tag (MDOT witness). Monument is in the centerline of old gravel road bed of the forner Joyfield Road. Signed by 3089
