Holden, Survey Record I, Page 106 and 107, set from original bearing trees. Undated: Frank Haswell, Surveyor's Record II, Page 72, says he set from original bearing trees. 1962: MDOT found a cedar stake and witnessed it. 1982: BCRC found a bolt and witnessed it. 1995: Sam Barnett, in an unrecorded survey shows he found a 1" square bar. B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: K-9: 1998: Found a 1" x 13" square headed bolt, 12" below existing grade, in a pile of large and small rocks all fitted together. Pulled rocks and found remains of cedar stake point, 28" below existing grade. Stake point fits well with Haswell distances to north and GLO distances to north and south. The stake point and iron bolt are also on a tree line occupation to the West. The Benzie County Peer Group accepted the 1" iron next to the wood stake as the best available evidence of the perpetuation of the original GLO corner. C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner.
