B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:

C-3 – Corner common to Sec.'s 5, 6, 7, & 8, T26N, R14W. FND. 1 3/4" O.D. x 2.2' long iron pipe. Removed and find 1 ½" O.D. iron pipe, (top bent), Down 2.6'. Dug down 4.2' and find that lower pipe is driven into Cedar cross timbers. No vertical post evidence. Pipes on centerline of old road grade SE'ly and fits centerline of Deadstream Road NW'ly if extended SE'ly. Position fits unrecorded surveys by H.J. Kleinbuizen and H. Bruning and Benzie Co. Rd. Commission alignment survey for Deadstream Road. Also found a ½" x 18" Rebar over 2" O.D. iron pipe S0°56'E 11.0' of 1 ¾" O.D. iron pipe. Excavated this position but no other evidence to support it. Also dug 4' S. of 1 3/4" pipe at Haswell distance from S. but found nothing. 1 3/4" O.D. iron pipe over 1 1/4" O.D. iron pipe accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
