- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:
- J4 C ¼, Sec. 11 Fd. ½" x 1.3' long iron rebar per Case at apparent location of old fence remain N & E. This iron is probably from Baden's surveys. Iron is 1.87' N. and 5.42' E. of calculated intersection of ¼ lines. Based on occupation and previous survey accepted the 1/2" iron rebar as the best available evidence of the position of the corner.
- 8 CW 1/16, Sec. 11 Set 2" Alum. Cap on 5/8" x 34" rebar per Standard BLM procedure. Fd. a 1/2" iron S36° 28' E 14.82' from '8', possibly per Baden but too far off to be acceptable.
