Down Anchor post for fence remains N is  $33'\pm N$ . Monument in gravel Rd. intersection for E-W & NE-SW Rds. It appears that Tuller found the Standard ¼ Corner in his survey in Sec. 5, based on his reference to an original BT. Monument accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
