1882: Knowles, Surveyor- 1.00 w. from Girard corner, this being the difference given in US minutes.

1963: Max Statler, Survey chief MSHD- 3/4" pipe, and witness.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Dug down 2.0° through new road and found 3/4" pipe as described in MSHD notes, all witness now gone.

Set ½" x 18" rebar iron with ID cap in CI monument box.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the

Rebar iron stake as noted above.

East 66.0', Girard Section corner

N 75 E 107.50'. Nail and tag in south side 30" Maple

S 50 E 53.70, Telephone pedestal

N 25 W 31.0', North end of 36" CMP culvert S 25 W 78.5', South end of 36" CMP culvert
