E.R. Reed, County Surveyor. Found 3/4" pipe 16" deep from witness of R.V.Terrill. Center of conc. post, N38-30E 40.7'.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found 3/4" iron rod from witness of concrete post, N38-30E 40.7'.

Set 2" x 18" Rebar iron with I.D. cap in CI monument box.
