

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found pointed stone as described above with 1" iron beside it. Excavation revealed the iron was driven inside a hollow clay tile. Held the location of the hollow clay tile as the true position for this corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: Replaced tile, pointed stone and 1" iron with standard Calhoun County Remonumentation Monument (Bernsten Monument).
