

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration;

Original Corner not set by GLO Survey.

May 9, 1998 - Scott E. Koch, PS #41103.

In an unrecorded survey by Ledy Survey Group, Project No. 98.0649, calls for a Found 1/2" Rebar, but gives no witnesses. It does show a distance of 2646.76' to G-2, and a distance of 2642.14' to F-3.



B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Searched at the apparent location of the corner and found a ½" Iron, 1.3'± South of the painted centerline of "A" Drive South, and 2.5'± East of a Tree row to the South. Dug to a depth of 3'± and found no additional evidence of the corner. 1/2" Iron lies 1.02 feet South & 2.38 feet East of intersection of  $\frac{1}{4}$  lines. Accepted  $\frac{1}{2}$  Iron as the best available evidence of the corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Replaced ½" Iron with Standard Berntsen Monument stamped Calhoun Co. Remon. & PS 41103 in Monument Box.
