e- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in-restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found capped iron in marsh as recorded by Milton Dekeyser on Sept. 20, 1972, in L.1032, P. 610. At that time they found pieces of tile set in 1887 with stone piled around it. All witness trees were dead. Found remains of corner fence post and stone pile.
