

Set ½" rod and cap(Found rod and cap 5434 - 33' West)

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

Found a 1" iron, L.S. 11367 in centerline of Gogomain Road. Found the four record bearing trees. Each tree has a nail and L.S. 11367 tag in the side. Accepted corner position as found and offset it prior to road reconstruction. Replaced corner after construction completed.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner (C-6) Corner is a 3/4" x 24" iron with plastic "Chippewa County Remonumentation" cap. Corner falls 0.8' East of the centerline of Gogomain Road (North-South, paved).
