The Buckler iron was used in several surveys by Northwoods Land Surveying prior to its removal during reconstruction of Riverside Drive. Corner position was re-established from existing survey control stations. Position checks with Witness Monument to East and Cade 14" Spruce (dead) to the Southwest. Established four new monument to East and Cade 14" Spruce (dead) to the Southwest. witnesses.
