DESCRIPTION IN DETAIL AS TO HOW CORNER WAS LOCATED AND IDENTIFIED OR RESTORED.

This corner replaced from witnesses recorded by C.M. Cade, C.E. in 1930. Found the 4" pipe laying beside road, apparently removed during road construction. Found what apears to be an original bearing tree, a green Tamarack, now 16" in Diameter, bearing N6820E, 71.7'. Large open face with scribe marks evident. Found remains of two witnesses by Cade; an aspen and a balsam, both dead.

The distance (2657.3') South to Sec. Cor. agrees with Cades distance.
