This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

Found a ½" iron with cap #27450 and all witness objects as shown in liber 7, page 313. Corner was established at record G.L.O. distance (8.58 feet) east of the standard corner common to Sections 35 & 36, T45N, R1W, on line with the township corner to the east. Accepted corner as found and set new measuring nails in the sides of the bearing trees.

- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

K-1 (T44N, R1W) Corner is $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 48" iron with plastic cap #27450. Witnesses:
