I, Keith R. Waters, in a field survey on November 20, 1998, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the comer points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and for that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

C-2 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 5 & 6, Town 44 North, Range 2 West

1845 - Original corner established by James Mullett.
Witnesses: Cedar 20, N57°E 19 links - Cedar 18, S82°W 37 links.

1896 - Chippewa County Surveyor Frederick H. Brown, RLS 944, notes for Section 6 indicate that "the outside of this section was established by Carleton when he surveyed the Village of Rudyard and did not make any changes. Brown's sketch of Section 6 shows the east line with distances of 2640 feet and 2697 feet on the south and north 1/2 miles respectively. GLO distances were 2640 feet and 2711.3 feet.

1991 - Sketch of subdivision of Section 6, William L. Karr, P.S. 27450, indicates that the east ¼ corner was computed by a proration of the above mentioned record County Surveyor distances between corners at C-1 and C-3.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

This corner is being reestablished as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

Found no evidence of the original corner. Reestablished corner on line between section corners C-1 to the north and C-3 to the south, at the proportionate distance according to the above mentioned County Surveyor notes. The overall mile distance is within approximately 2 feet of that as shown is said County Surveyor notes.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner.

Placed a ¾" x 24" rebar with a plastic Chippewa County Remonumentation cap at the corner location, which falls approximately 1 foot west of the centerline of Tilson Road. Witnesses:
