

5. Private Claims

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

G-3 Corner Common to Sections 3, 4, 9, & 10, T44N, R2W

1845 - Original corner (6" Aspen) established by James Mullett.

1897 - Chippewa County Surveyor Frederick H. Brown, RLS 944, notes for Section 3 indicate "corner by Chamberlain of Mackinac County."

1915 - Brown's note for Section 9 state "took the corner as it was used for roads."

1927 - Chippewa County Surveyor corner tie book shows a cement post and 11/2" gas pipe, with various witnesses.

1959 - Liber 3, page 227, Chippewa County corner records. Michigan State Highway Department surveyor Ray Walker, this corner is a 1" iron pipe alongside wood hub. Witnesses:

Power Pole, N35°W 40.76' - Telephone Pole, S42°E 40.47' - Fence Post, S57°W 42.47'.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program. Found a 1" iron pipe in the intersection of Hantz Road and 19 Mile Road. All previous visitions of Surveyor notes are gone. Distances to adjacent corners check well with above mentioned 1897 and 1915 County Surveyor notes. Found a 1" iron pipe in the intersection of Hantz Road and 19 Mile Road. All previous witness objects mentioned above

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner

Found a 1" iron pipe at the corner location, which falls in the centerline intersection of Hantz Road and 19 Mile Road (M-48). Witnesses:

Nail and plastic witness tag #33142 in side of Power Pole, N80°E 151.82' Nail and plastic witness tag #33142 in side of Corner Fence Post, N44°W 67.86' Northwesterly corner of triangular concrete Right-of-way Marker, S61°E 58.88' Nail and plastic witness tag #33142 in side of Power Pole, S08°W 312.12'
